

ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

Quality of the delivered educational programmes

In 2014 the educational programme «Linguistics » became one of the 7 winners of the competition for development of new innovative educational programmes with award of the status «Innovative Educational programme of Altai State University».

In 2017 the educational programmes 45.03.02 Linguistics (Practice and Theory of Translation) and 45.04.01 Philology (Philological Principles of Translation) were highly appraised among employers. The University and the Barnaul Machine Tool Plant signed cooperation agreement that provides for undertaking work experience internships at the enterprise and further promotion of graduates employability.

Providing up-to-date contents of education

Contents of the educational programmes correspond to up-to-date level of development of science, technology, culture, economy and social sphere.

The University actively cooperates with the studio of the English language «Aapple», the Barnaul Machine Tool Plant, the Centre of Humanitarian Development «Sunshine», the language school of intensive learning «Elite» on training of a highly qualified staff. A system of the University work on graduates' employability is developed.

Teaching staff

Basic education and qualification of all teachers correspond to the requirements.

The teaching staff actively participates in research activities on priority areas for development of science and technology in the Russian Federation.

Independent assessment of knowledge

More than 80% of students show the highest level of training (IV) on the main disciplines in the frames of the Federal Internet Exam in the Sphere of Professional Education (2016-2017).

Educational resources

The educational programmes are provided with laboratory equipment. The language laboratory provides training sessions on oral consecutive interpretation and principles of simultaneous translation.

The resources of electronic information educational environment of the University are widely used in the educational process. It provides:

- an access to curricula, working programmes of disciplines, practice, publications of electronic library systems, and electronic educational resources noted in the working programmes;
- documentation of the educational process, results of interim assessment and acquisition of the educational programme;

- all kinds of training sessions and assessment of learning outcomes implementation of which provides for use of electronic education and distance learning technologies;
- making electronic portfolio of a student, including storing of works and reviews by any participant of the educational process;
- cooperation of the participants of the educational process, including synchronous and (or) asynchronous interaction with the help of the Internet.

Research activity

Research studies of the teachers of the Department are conducted in two priority areas: «Linguistic Theory of Thesaurus» and «Linguo-evocational Study of Communication». 3 articles of Scopus, 6 articles of Web of Science, 7 monographs, the Russian-English thesaurus «Altai Translation Guide» were published for the last 3 years. The Department holds the scientific conferences «Language and Literature in Multicultural World» and «Intercultural Communication and Mass Media» every year.

Academic mobility of students

For the last three years 24 students of the Faculty took part in grant competitions, 15 students participated in the programmes of academic mobility, 2 of them are students of the programme Philology.

Employability of graduates

Graduates of the field of study «Philological Principles of Translation» are in stable demand on the labour market. Employability was 100% for the last 5 years. Graduates are in demand in the Altai and other regions of the Russian Federation.

The educational programme «Linguistics» (45.03.02) successfully passed independent assessment of education quality on certified accredited pedagogic assessment materials in the frames of the project «Federal Internet Exam in the Sphere of Professional Education» (Quality Certificate $N_{\rm P}$ 2016/2/198 dated 03.03.2017).

COMPLIANCE OF THE EXTERNAL REVIEW OUTCOMES WITH THE STANDARDS

STANDARD 1. Policy (goals, development strategy) and quality assurance procedures of the educational programme

Compliance with the standard: substantial compliance

Good practice:

An internal system of quality assurance for development and implementation of the educational programmes on the basis of necessary normative documents is in place.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended to involve non-governmental organizations (for example, the Union of Translators of Russia), regional and municipal authorities as stakeholders on graduates employability in formation of policy of quality assurance of the educational programmes.

It is advisable to vary forms of employers' involvement to improve the system of quality assurance at all stages of design and implementation of the cluster of the educational programmes (questionnaires, formulation of learning outcomes with the account of the specific character of job functions, involvement of employers in internal audit).

It is recommended to conduct surveys of students of the educational institution studied in foreign universities due to the programmes of academic mobility to improve procedures of the internal system of quality assurance (comparison of training organization in Altai State University and the foreign university, revealing of strong and weak points).

STANDARD 2. Design and approval of programmes

Compliance with the standard: **substantial compliance**

Good practice:

The educational programmes correspond to normative requirements. Regional demand for experts in priority areas for development of the region are taken into account.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended to design the educational programmes on demand of employers (for example, the master's degree programme that takes into account requirements of certain organizations and enterprises).

It is advisable to consider the possibility of learning several languages (for example, Spanish, French) to open new programmes required in the labour market.

It is necessary to increase the number of graduation works made upon the official request of employers.

STANDARD 3. Student-centered learning and assessment

Compliance with the standard: substantial compliance

Good practice:

Different forms of independent assessment of knowledge and students' competences are widely used.

An access to electronic educational resources (guidelines, tests, etc.) is open.

Students have the possibility to serve internships at the enterprises with a perspective of further employment.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended to increase opportunities of serving internships at subject-specific enterprises (for example, commercial and noncommercial enterprises, advertising companies, administration, etc.). It is advisable to use all available resources to provide linguistic support of international events by students and teachers.

It is advisable to improve educational internship at the initial stage and take into account its applied character (for example, to organize professional training of a translator).

STANDARD 4. Student admission, support of academic achievements and graduation

Compliance with the standard: **substantial compliance**

Good practice:

Work on career guidance is carried out by integration of a triad «school – higher education institution – employer».

Students are interested in academic, research and cultural activities of the University.

Areas for improvement:

It is advisable to give a European Diploma Supplement on a free-of-charge basis.

It is recommended for the International Department to improve monitoring of programmes of academic mobility that can be financially attractive for students and teachers (it is advisable to pay special attention to the programmes of ERASMUS MUNDUS).

STANDARD 5. Teaching staff

Compliance with the standard: substantial compliance

Good practice:

Academic degree holders rate is high: among 14 teachers there are 2 Doctors and 11 Candidates of Sciences. Their theses are directly connected with the disciplines of the educational programmes undergoing accreditation.

Students have many possibilities to meet their educational demands. Teachers successfully cooperate with students.

Alastair Mitchell, native speaker and certified teacher of CELTA and IELTS (Great Britain), is involved in the educational process.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended for the Dean's Office to consider the possibility of annual financial planning and secondment of teachers of the Department.

It is advisable to involve foreign teachers in the educational process with the account of regional particular characteristics and development of the Faculty and University.

STANDARD 6. Learning resources and student support

Compliance with the standard: **substantial compliance**

Good practice:

An electronic reference room of remote access to resources of the Yeltsin Presidential Library is opened on the basis of the University library. Events important for the University and the region are held there (international and regional scientific conferences, Faculty Days, round tables, and subject-related webinars).

Areas for improvement:

The University administration and the Dean's Office should pay attention to annual financial support of material and technical resources of the Department with the account of modernization of the educational process (software support, linguistic and translation programmes for universities, modern computers, etc.)

It is recommended to give students the possibility to receive information about academic mobility and its support system (for example, to appoint a teacher responsible for timely information sharing to students about possibilities of participation in international projects).

It is advisable to renew computers of the library and buy equipment to train simultaneous interpreting as an innovative educational resource.

STANDARD 7. Collection, analysis and use of information for managing the educational institution

Compliance with the standard: **substantial compliance**

Good practice:

Students and teachers are involved in analysis and monitoring of information about quality of the educational programmes.

Due to united information network, the Federal Internet Exam in the Sphere of Professional Education is held at the University. It allows to carry out external independent assessment of students' academic achievements.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended to comparatively analyze the educational programmes of the Altai State University and similar educational programmes of foreign and Russian universities to make a system of corrective actions for improvement of the educational programmes.

STANDARD 8. Public information

Compliance with the standard: **substantial compliance**

Good practice:

A list of the best students is published.

Information about vacancies is published on the official web-site.

Teachers of the Department actively participate in preparation and holding of language Olympiads for pupils of the Altai Region.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended to use active forms of work with journalists as joint seminars with supervisors of the programmes, media tours, and round tables.

STANDARD 9. On-going monitoring and periodic assessment of the educational programmes

Compliance with the standard: substantial compliance

Good practice:

Contents and updating of the educational programmes are regularly discussed at the meetings of the Department.

A feedback system with students and employers provides improvement of education quality.

Areas for improvement:

It is recommended to develop the mechanism of involvement of graduates in monitoring of the educational process on a regular basis.


STANDARD 10. Cyclical external quality assurance of the educational programmes
