

ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

Quality of the delivered educational programmes

Quality of the educational programmes is provided by high qualification of the teaching staff and its systematic improvement, research activities of teachers and students, close cooperation with employers, development and continuous improvement of teaching materials on disciplines, including the electronic ones, use of innovative methods (case-methods, business games, portfolio method, etc.).

Providing up-to-date contents of education

Up-to-date contents of education are provided by annual renewal and correction of the educational programmes, curricula and programmes of disciplines. Relevance of the educational programmes, programmes of work experience internships, programmes of the State Final Examination is provided by their agreement with external experts among representatives of the professional community. The University signed cooperation agreements with the «Federal Fiscal Enterprise of the Federal Service for State Registration» in the Ulyanovsk Region, the administration of the municipal structures of the Ulyanovsk Region and other state organizations of the region. The branch of the Department «Land Management and Cadastre» was created on the base of the LLC «StroyProjectIzyskanie».

Teaching staff

24 teachers having relevant education work with the programme 21.03.02 «Land Management and Cadastre». 80% of them are Doctors or Candidates of Sciences.

Staff policy of the University is aimed at formation of the unique teaching staff with high qualification. There are famous experienced professors and young talented teachers. Many teachers have state honorary degrees and won international and national competitions. The percentage of regular teachers is more than 90%.

More than 5% of teachers are heads and workers of subject-specific organizations, enterprises and institutions.

Independent assessment of knowledge

In 2016 the University was among the winners of the national competition «The Best Higher Education Institutions of the Russian Federation - 2016». On 14 of June 2017 2^{nd} year students of the field of study «Land Management and Cadastre» participated in the 4^{th} stage of the experiment of the Federal Education and Science Supervision Agency on objective assessment of students' knowledge of the discipline «Engineer Land-Use Planning».

Educational resources

Material and technical resources provide implementation of all kinds of laboratory, practical, research, disciplinary and interdisciplinary activities that are provided by the curriculum and correspond to sanitary and fire-safety regulations.

There are 5 classrooms at the Faculty of Agrotechnology, Land Resources and Food Production, one of which is provided with technical training resources. Seminars, laboratory, practical and other kinds of sessions are carried out in 22 specialized classrooms. There is a computer class with an access to the Internet.

Laboratories are provided with necessary equipment.

The testing ground with the area of 487 ha and providing ground are used as the training bases.

Research activity

Teachers and students do active research. 19 course books and study guides, 2 of which are with the signature stem of the Academic Methodological Association, and 2 monographs were published for the last 5 years. 105 scientific works were published in total. 11 of them are published in HAC journals and 3 works in Scopus journals.

Active research is carried out together with the students. More than 220 student works were published in different conferences.

Academic mobility of students

The Faculty actively develops academic mobility of students. Students actively participate in scientific internships, Russian scientific conferences, national and international scientific Olympiads. Over the last years the University signed agreements about academic mobility of students with Zhangir khan West Kazakhstan Agrarian Technical University and Samara State Agricultural Academy.

The University participates in different international exchange programmes. Presentations of international educational programmes are regularly held (German Educational Centre DEILA-Nienburg, Lower Saxony; Union «Agriculture and Ecological Balance with the Eastern Europe» LOGO e.V; Farming Enterprise «AgriLIDA», Denmark).

Employability of graduates

The University is the Regional Centre of Graduate Employment and Labour Market Adaptation. It actively cooperates with the bodies of executive power and employers in land management and cadastre on staff training and employability.

Graduates are in demand in the Ulyanovsk Region and other regions of the Russian Federation (the Samara Region, the Republic of Tatarstan, etc.).

International projects

The Faculty actively participates in different international projects. A. Naumov, Associate Professor of the Department of Soil Management and Plant Cultivation, is an expert of the subject-specific championship of professional skills in agriculture on the standards of WorldSkills. Students actively participate in different international conferences under teachers' supervision: «Agrarian Science and Education at the Present Stage of Development: Practice, Problems and Their Solutions», «Science and Agroindustrial Complex», «Topical Issues of Land Management and Cadastre at the Modern Stage», «Problems of Maintenance and Transformation of Cultivated Lands: International Internet Conference dedicated to the 225th Anniversary of S. Aksakov», «Management of Land Property Relations», «Topical Issues of Environmental Engineering, Cadastre and Land Use», «Economic Changes in the Russian Land Property Complex: Analysis and Ways of Solution».

The educational programme «Land Management and Cadastre» (21.03.02) successfully passed independent assessment of education quality on certified accredited pedagogic assessment materials (APAM) in the frames of the project «Federal Internet Exam in the Sphere of Professional Education» (Quality Certificate N° 2014/2/387 dated 05.03.2015).


